* This plan represents the minimum within the art history area of concentration, however, students are encouraged to select additional ARH courses or pursue a minor in a different area. Suggested departments for non-art history electives/minor study include: African American Studies, Anthropology, Archaeology, Classical Studies, English, German and Russian (including Chinese and Japanese Studies), History, Interior Architecture, Media Studies, Philosophy, Religious Studies, Romance Languages, Women and Gender Studies.
Degree requires 122 semester hours, to include at least 36 hours at or above the 300 course level. No major requirements may be met with a grade lower than C.
Minimum GPA on attempted semester hours: no less than 2.0
Residency requirement: 31 semester hours, 12 of which must be in the major and 9 of which must be in the minor (if a minor is sought).
