¹ All students majoring in Social Work are required to complete a two-course (6 s.h.) culture and diversity requirement in order to be admitted to field instruction. The requirement can be met by establishing foreign language (including American Sign Language) proficiency at the elementary level (ie., Foreign Language 111 & 112), or two courses from the following list of NCCC courses: HIS 222, HIS 223, HUM 150, REL 111, or REL 221.

² Admission to the program requires students to earn a grade of "C" or better in certain UNCG courses. NCCC students should seek dual-enrollment/consortium opportunities to complete these courses before their first semester at UNCG.

Admission to the major is based upon a minimum GPA of 2.50 and completion/submission of the B.S.W. Application Packet (by December 1 or May 1 of the year in which the student is seeking admission).

Degree requires at least 122 semester hours, to include 36 hours at or above the 300 course level.

Minimum GPA on attempted semester hours: no less than 2.0

Residency requirement: 31 semester hours, 12 of which must be in the major and 9 of which must be in the minor (if a minor is sought).
