NOTE: Unless you claimed not to be a North Carolina resident, the public institution you are applying to will first determine if you qualify for in-state tuition based on your residency intent and actions. If you are determined not to qualify for in-state tuition, the institution will consider your request for the military tuition benefit. To be considered for the military tuition benefit, you must:

- Attach an affidavit from the appropriate military authority attesting to your duty status and duty location.

NOTE: The military tuition benefit application must be filed before the first day of classes for which the benefit is sought, and the benefit does not self-renew (i.e., an application must be filed for each academic year).

Military Tuition Benefit for Non-North Carolina Residents

For students entering or attending North Carolina public colleges or universities, NC law provides that a dependent of a member of the armed forces who does not qualify as a resident for tuition purposes may be eligible to be charged tuition reduced below the out-of-state rate if the individual is abiding in North Carolina household of the armed forces member and the armed forces member is in North Carolina incident to active military duty and that duty is performed at, or from, a duty station in this state.

NOTE: Unless you claimed not to be a North Carolina resident, the public institution you are applying to will first determine if you qualify for in-state tuition based on your residency intent and actions. If you are determined not to qualify for in-state tuition, the institution will consider your request for the military tuition benefit. To be considered for the military tuition benefit, you must:

- Submit an affidavit from the appropriate military authority attesting to your sponsor's duty status and duty location with your application submittal statement.

NOTE: The military tuition benefit application must be filed before the first day of classes for which the benefit is sought, and the benefit does not self-renew (i.e., an application must be filed for each academic year).
